****Race # 3 will be scored in the 2021 Southern Bay Distance Racing Series, use the PHRF CR handicap, and provide a start for a CRCA fleet.**

ENTRY DUE DATE/TIME: All entries must be electronic and received by 1800 on the night before the race. No same day or paper entries will be accepted. Enter and pay online at <http://ccvracing.us/race-registration/>

ENTRY FEE:

CCVR Race Members – Prepaid for Series. No further entry required.

CCVR Distance Series – Prepaid for Event # 418 (Race 3) No further entry required.

All others: Per race -- \$35 for USSA or CBYRA members; \$40 for Non-USSA/CBYRA members.

Early bird special: \$5 off the above per race fees if paid more than 48 hours before the race date.

EQUIPMENT: All boats must meet US Sailing's "Nearshore" Safety Equipment Requirements.

STARTING LINE: Vicinity of CCV Mark "H" (**Harbor**). The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the Race Committee Boat and the designated government mark or a drop mark.

FINISH LINE: Between a staff displaying a blue flag on the Race Committee Boat and the mark designated by the posted course, unless the course has been shortened after the start.

COURSES: Courses will be as designated in the CCVR GENERAL SAILING INSTRUCTIONS. Races 1&2 and 4&5 will be drop mark or combo courses. Race 3 will be a middle-distance race around government marks.

STARTING SIGNALS: RRS 26

<u>CLASS</u>	<u>TIME (2nd race of the day to follow ASAP on Days 1 & 3)</u>
PHRF A	1100 WARNING (Day 2 Warning will be at noon, due to early-morning street closures for the Crawlin' Crab half-marathon)
VIPER 640	(See Note 1 below)
PHRF B/C	(Classes are combined...start together and scored together)
PHRF N	(Non-Spinnaker, 2 headsails allowed)
CRUISING	(Non-Spinnaker, only 1 headsail allowed)
CRCA	(Race 3 only)

NOTE 1: If sufficient Viper 640s are present there will be a Viper start.

NOTE 2: CRCA scoring will be done separately using CRCA ratings.

TIME LIMIT: For Races 1 & 2 and 4 & 5 time limit in each fleet is 2.5 hours and remaining boats must finish within 30 mins. of the first finisher in that fleet. For Race 3, the time limit is 4 hours for the first boat in each fleet and remaining boats must finish within 1 hour of the first boat.

PROTESTS: Due: In writing within one hour of Race Committee arriving at the dock.

Heard: 1900 hours on the Monday following the race at HYC.

AWARDS / SOCIAL: Assuming COVID-19 restrictions are not in place, there will be a bottled beer and wine celebration after racing on Day 3 (Oct. 10) at the HYC Gazebo. Attendees are still asked to wear masks when not actively drinking and maintain 6' social distancing
