ENTRY DUE DATE/TIME: All entries must be electronic (<http://ccvracing.us/race-registration/>) and received by 1600 on the day before the race. No same day or paper entries will be accepted. Any fleet change must also be electronic and prior to 1600 on the day before the race. See CCVR Race Instructions.

ENTRY FEE:

CCVR Race Members = Prepaid for entire Series. (Entry paid for season and no more paperwork!!)

CCVR Distance Series Members = Prepaid for Race 3

All others must pay by the race. \$35 per day for US Sailing and CBYRA members. \$40 for non-members.

COURSES:

Races 1 & 2 and 4 & 5 = Two drop mark windward/leeward races each day. As per CCVR General S.I.s
Scoring will be PHRF Time on Distance. Both days racing in harbor.

Race 3 = One middle distance race in Bay using fixed marks as per CCVR General S.I.s.

This race counts toward CCVR Distance Series and BBSA Southern Bay Distance Series.

PHRF Scoring will be done using the PHRF CR Rating.

ORC Cruiser scoring will be done using the ORC Triple Number All-Purpose Rating.

EQUIPMENT: All boats must meet US Sailing's "Nearshore" Safety Equipment Requirements.

STARTING LINE:

Days 1 & 3 = In harbor in vicinity of CCVR Mark "H" (Harbor). The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the RC Signal Boat and the adjacent drop mark.

Day 2 = In Bay at CCVR Mark "Y" (Bay). The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the RC Signal Boat and Mark "Y".

FINISH LINE: Between a staff displaying a blue flag on the RC Finish Boat and the mark designated by the posted course, unless the course has been shortened after the start.

STARTING SIGNALS: RRS 26 as modified by CCVR General Sailing Instructions

CLASS **TIME (2nd race of the day to follow ASAP on Days 1 & 3)**

PHRF A 1100 WARNING

VIPER 640 (If sufficient Vipers are present, the RC will notify the fleet via VHF-72 prior to Warning)

PHRF B/C (Classes are combined...started together and scored together)

ORC Cruiser (Race 3 only)

PHRF N (Non-Spinnaker, 2 headsails allowed)

CRUISING (Non-Spinnaker, only 1 headsail allowed)

TIME LIMIT: For Races 1 & 2 and 4 & 5, the time limit in each fleet is 2.5 hours and remaining boats must finish within 30 mins. of the first finisher in their fleet. For Race 3, the time limit is 4 hours for the first boat in each fleet and remaining boats must finish within 1 hour of the first boat.

PROTESTS: Due: In writing within one hour of Race Committee arriving at the dock.

Heard: 1900 hours on the Monday following the race at HYC...unless earlier by mutual agreement.

AWARDS / SOCIAL: Daily awards and beer will be given following racing each day at HYC. Hot dogs will be available following Races 4 & 5. Overall series awards will be given at the annual CCVR Awards Party in October.
