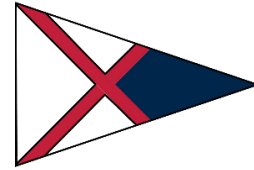


CCV RACING 2021 Triple Tunnel Terror Saturday, July 24, 2021



San Francisco Bay has lots of bridges and hence the fun Three Bridge Fiasco. We have lots of tunnels, so let's have a three-tunnel terror! The idea is simple: three marks near the Hampton Road Bridge-, Monitor Merrimac Bridge-, and Midtown Tunnels, a pursuit start, and you can go around the marks in any order/direction. The safe course is 22 miles, but if you can skirt the shallows go for it, but that's the terror. Monohulls and multihulls are welcome, and PHRF (CR ratings), CRCA, and CMA (Multihull) handicaps will be used. The race will have a pursuit start, marks can be rounded in any order, and you can try to sail the shortest course possible – what could go wrong? CCVR is hoping this new TTT will be the most fun you can have racing.

ENTRY DUE DATE / TIME: All entries must be electronic (<http://ccvracing.us/race-registration/>) and received by 1800 Thursday 22 July. No same day or paper entries will be accepted.

ENTRY FEE and PAYMENT: \$35, that's it. Enter race and pay online: <http://ccvracing.us/race-registration/>.

EQUIPMENT: US Sailing's "Nearshore" Safety Equipment Requirements.

STARTING LINE: CCVR Mark H. The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the Race Committee Boat and Mark H.

FINISH LINE: Between a staff displaying a blue flag on the Race Committee Boat and Mark H.

COURSE MARKS: The three tunnel marks are listed on the CCVR web site, <http://ccvracing.us/racing/>

STARTING SEQUENCE and SIGNALS: As a pursuit start, starting times will be posted on the CCVR web site, <http://ccvracing.us/racing/> by 1700 on 23 July. On race day the first warning will be at 0755, with the first start at 0800. Each yacht's preparatory signal will be four minutes before her scheduled start time.

COMMERCIAL TRAFFIC: Competitors are strongly reminded to review CCVR's 2021 General Sailing Instructions 20 and not interfere with the transit of commercial and naval vessels.

TIME LIMIT: Yachts must finish by 2000 (8pm).

PROTESTS: Due: In writing within one hour of Race Committee arriving at the dock.
Heard: 1900 hours on the Monday following the race at HYC.

AWARDS / SOCIAL: Due to COVID-19 concerns, there will be no post-race social. Race awards will be presented at an end-of-season gathering similar to that which occurred in 2020.
